

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

## Field/Capstone

(ambulance)

- + TEAM LEAD (proving you're ready)
- + Primary assessment\*
- + Secondary assessment\*
- + Interventions (so we can SEE your "management plan")

\*Independent skills (you don't have to be independent on ALL skills, just these)

### Clinical

(brick and mortar location)

- + Primary assessment\*
- + Secondary assessment\*
- + Management Plan (bc you usually cannot be "Team Lead," use this skill to show what you WOULD do if you were in charge of the pt— available for Clin reports ONLY)



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
